The Rector writes:-

This week the main services at St Nicholas and St Barnabas have a slightly different focus – with St Barnabas keeping the 2nd Sunday of Advent and the 9.45 St Nicholas congregation celebrating the Patronal Festival (St Nicholas' Day having been on 6th December). Thankfully the traditions surrounding St Nicholas also resonate with the themes of Advent as we prepare ourselves to receive anew the Christ child into our lives and hearts. As I was reflecting on this I received news that, in its meeting earlier in the week, our Charities & Community Committee had chosen the charities we are supporting in our collections this Christmas to have a particular emphasis on children and the homeless. St Nicholas would certainly have approved! This year these 'special' collections will be divided with a quarter each going to:

(local charity) **Golden Lions Children's Trust**

(national charity) **the Samaritans**
(international charity) **Habitat for Humanity** and our parish ministry.

This is, of course, in addition to the collections for the Children's Society (the Christingle services and the collection boxes/tubes in many of our homes at present) and also the collection of (unwrapped, please!) gifts for children and families that are brought to the "Celebration of Christmas" service (15 Dec) and the Crib Services (24 Dec). May the experience of sharing some of what we have with those who have less bring us all a deep sense of gratitude and joy.

Collect & Post-Communion Prayer

Collect –

O Lord, raise up, we pray, your power and come among us, and with great might succour us; that whereas, through our sins and wickedness we are grievously hindered in running the race that is set before us, your bountiful grace and mercy may speedily help and deliver us; through Jesus Christ your Son our Lord, to whom with you and the Holy Spirit, be honour and glory, now and for ever. **Amen.**

Feast Day of St Nicholas

Nicholas was a native of the western part of what is now Asiatic Turkey. He became Bishop of Myra in the fourth century, and there are many stories of his love for God and for his neighbour; Nicholas, became Bishop of Myra, c.326 and was present at the Council of Nicaea.

He is Patron Saint of pawn brokers, sailors, children and others, also many countries and churches.
